## **Industrial Activities** Requiring Coverage under the Industrial General Plan

The list provided below describes the types of industrial activities that must obtain coverage under a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) industrial storm water permit, unless conditionally excluded:

- 💧 Category One – Facilities with Storm Water Effluent Limitations
- 💧 Category Two – Manufacturing
- 💧 Category Three – Mineral, Metal, Oil and Gas
- 💧 Category Four – Hazardous Waste, Treatment or Disposal Facilities
- 💧 Category Five – Landfills
- 💧 Category Six – Recycling Facilities
- 💧 Category Seven – Steam Electric Plants
- 💧 Category Eight – Transportation Facilities
- 💧 Category Nine – Treatment Works
- 💧 Category Ten – Construction Activity

Although construction activity is included in the definition of “storm water discharges associated with industrial activity,” construction activities require construction storm water permits, not industrial storm water permits, under the NPDES Storm Water Program.

- 💧 Category Eleven – Light Industry



## **How the General Permit** **Affects You!!!**

In 1991 the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) issued a General Storm Water Discharge Permit for industrial sites which includes the eleven industrial categories listed on the left panel. A general storm water discharge permit was issued in 1992 for construction activities on 5 or more acres of land.

The owner/operator of listed industrial sites are required to obtain coverage under the most recent State General Permit for storm water discharge associated with industrial sites issued in 1997. On December 8<sup>th</sup>, 1999, the construction General Permit was reissued to include coverage requirements for construction sites that disturb a total of one or more acres of land. Both of the current permits include Sampling and Analysis (SAP) and training requirements.



## **What You Have To Do!!!**

1. Prepare a Notice of Intent (NOI) and Submit it to SWRCB
2. Pay Applicable Fee to SWRCB
3. Prepare Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) and SAP
4. Perform Inspections
5. Perform Monitoring
6. GET TRAINING!!!



## **Construction Activities** Requiring Coverage under the Construction General Permit

- 💧 Any construction activity including clearing, grading, excavation and demolition that disturbs one or more acres of land.
- 💧 Any land disturbance on a site that is part of a large common plan of development or sale with a planned disturbance of one acre.
- 💧 Any repaving operations of one or more acres that create fine-grained sediments that are not immediately removed from the site and properly disposed of at an acceptable facility.
- 💧 Any construction activity, including sites disturbing less than one acre, that are designated by SWRCB or EPA to have a potential for contribution to a violation of a water quality standard or may significantly contribute pollutants to waters of the United States.

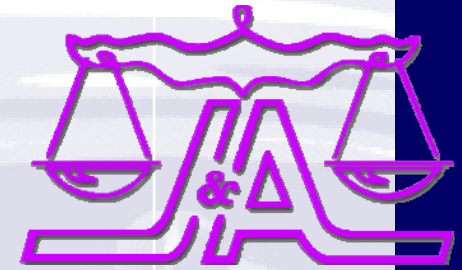
